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1. MANAGEMENT'S MONTHLY REPORT

Some of the highlights of the AGM include:

NB. This pravaram should not be used when prostrating to god, saints, ladies and group of elders.

2. For Rig Veda – (a) Aaswalaayana, (b) Kaathyaayana

SRI HANUMAN

Sri Hanuman is also known as Pawansuta, Mahaveer and Bajrangabali. He is worshipped, not only all over India but also in foreign lands where Hindus have migrated or elected domicile. Every temple of Sri Rama has a murti or idol of Sri Hanuman. In the front courtyard of every home, there is a small temple where the red flag of Sri Hanuman proudly dances and floats in the open sky and where everyday a diyya is lit in prayer and in reverence to

Mahaveer, the embodiment of the ideal devotee. Sri Hanuman possessed many virtuous qualities; his deep devotion to His Lord Sri Rama was unparalleled. Great rejoicings and festivities followed the return of Sri Rama to Ayodhya and his crowning as the King. After a few days, life went back to normal and all the monkeys who had served as warriors in his army returned to their home in the forest. Only one stayed behind; he was sad to leave the Master of his heart. He stood quietly in a corner and looked at Sri Rama with eyes filled with Love. Sri Rama noticed his fervent devotee and asked: "O mighty hero how am I to compensate you for all you have done for me and for my family?" Many would have wanted wealth, name or fame, approbation or recognition or VIP line in return for their services. But Sri Hanuman was above all these: "I desire nothing, Prabhu!" Then the Queen, Sita Mother, removed a valuable necklace of pearls from her neck and offered it to the humble Sri Hanuman. Sri Hanuman took the necklace from Sita Mother. However, strange as it may sound, Sri Hanuman went back to a corner and there he started to bite at each of the pearls with his teeth cutting them into pieces. Everybody was astounded at his curious behaviour. Some wondered why the noble and great warrior Sri Hanuman was behaving like a monkey. Was it the monkey mind...? No! Premaswarupa! Hanuman was breaking the pearls to see if the name of his sweet Lord Rama was written in them. He replied to Sita Mother, who chided him: Mata, I cannot accept any thing which does not bear the name of Sri Rama!" A sage then laughed and ironically remarked: "Surely your body bears the name of Sri Rama!" "Prabhu!" Sri Hanuman cried out at the unexpected remark, looking at Sri Rama; Sri Rama raised his right hand and blessed him; Sri Hanuman then tore his chest open with his mighty hands and Lo! Sri Rama and Sita Mother were seated in his heart!" Dil me Raam, Hanth me Kaam- the Lord in our heart, let us serve! Jaya Bajarangabali! Jaya Sri Rama!

WHAT IS CHITRA POURNAMI ?

All full moon days are considered auspicious, but certain full moons in certain months are more significant than others. One of which is the pournami coinciding with the star "Chithirai" in the month of chithirai and is known as Chithira Pournami. Special prayers are conducted to invoke the blessings of Chitrugupta who is said to write down the account of each individual ie. good deeds and bad deeds committed by each of us. It is also said that this pournami is more auspicious if it happens to fall on a Saturday, Sunday or Thursday. This event is based on *Month, Thithi and Star*.

FOOD AND YOU

Health is necessary for gaining this world and the next, for earning worldly and other worldly progress, to realize the very purpose for which the Self has embodied itself in the human form, namely, to become aware of its source, the Eternal Absolute. In order to attain this goal, the ideals of righteousness, prosperity, moral desire and release from grief have to be practiced with the help of a sound mind in a sound body.

Every activity of man is dependent on the energy he derives from the intake of food. The spiritual disciplines he

ventures upon depend for their success on the quantity and quality of food taken by the spiritual aspirant, even during the preliminary preparations recommended by Patanjali.

Raajasik food generates virulent thoughts. By consuming non-vegetarian food we develop brutal mentalities. Those who are practicing meditation must abstain from meat. We should also remember constantly that ahimsa or non-violence is the supreme Dharma. When you kill an animal you give him suffering, pain, harm. God is in every creature, so how can you give such pain? Animals did not come for the purpose of supplying food to human beings. They came to work out their own life in the world.

If you do not smoke, you escape a number of illnesses that follow that raajasik practice. Any intoxicant or stimulant, because it disturbs nature's trend, is harmful. Smoking destroys health, happiness, energy and even charm. Smoke will not quench your thirst or fill the hungry stomach. It disfigures your face and denigrates your lungs. It debilitates you and makes you diseased. Control yourself and do not yield to the snares of friends or society, or what is miscalled social convention, and become a prey to this and other bad habits.

The mind is the puppet of the food that is consumed by man. It is prompted one way or the other by the subtle pull of the food it is fed on. The quality of the food determines the direction of the desire that diverts the mental flow. That is why in the Gita as well as in all scriptural texts, saatwik food is recommended for the upward-seeking individual. Mind means desire, resolve (sankalpa), something sought for. When the Formless desired Form, the Universe arose; so, mind is the creative principle, the Maya or illusion that desired the very first desire to "be many." When it is fed on raajas - passion and emotion, activity and adventure - it gallops into the world with the plunge of desire! It brings man deeper into the morass. When it is fed on taamsik food which dulls, inebriates, blunts reason and induces sloth, the mind is callous, inert and useless for uplifting man.

It may take many lives for a man before he knows what is best for him, and is able to chalk out his own future without harming himself or others, that he is aware of the pitfalls on the way. So, it is best to trust the experience of the sages, who were filled with compassion and who were moved out of that compassion to illumine the path of liberation. This experience is enshrined in the Vedas. Faith in the Vedas irrigates the heart and makes it yield the harvest of universal love.
